Morgan Show Violations, Part I

ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES

This is official notice of the imposition of Administrative Penalties, pursuant to Chapter 4, GR412, and/or Chapter 6, GR616, offered by the Federation and accepted by the following parties, and approved by the Hearing Committee in lieu of hearings:

ALBERT CELECKI of Pittsford, NY, violated Chapter 12, GR1207, of this Federation in connection with the New York Morgan Horse Show held September 13-16, 2006, in that **ALBERT CELECKI**, as ringmaster, officiated a class in which his daughter was an exhibitor. For this violation, it was determined that **ALBERT CELECKI** be censured, pursuant to Chapter 7, GR703.1a.

Chapter 7, GR703.1a.

In connection with the Southern States Morgan Horse Show held on May 24-27, 2006, **JILL EIDE**, as owner, exhibited the horse **WHERE THE SIDEWALK ENDS** after it had been administered and/or contained in its body 2-(1-hydroxyethyl) promazine sulfoxide. For this violation, it was determined that **JILL EIDE**, as owner, must return for redistribution all trophies, prizes, ribbons and monies, if any, won by **WHERE THE SIDEWALK ENDS** at said competition and must pay a \$200 fee to the competition in connection with this penalty, pursuant to Chapter 4, GR406.15.
